

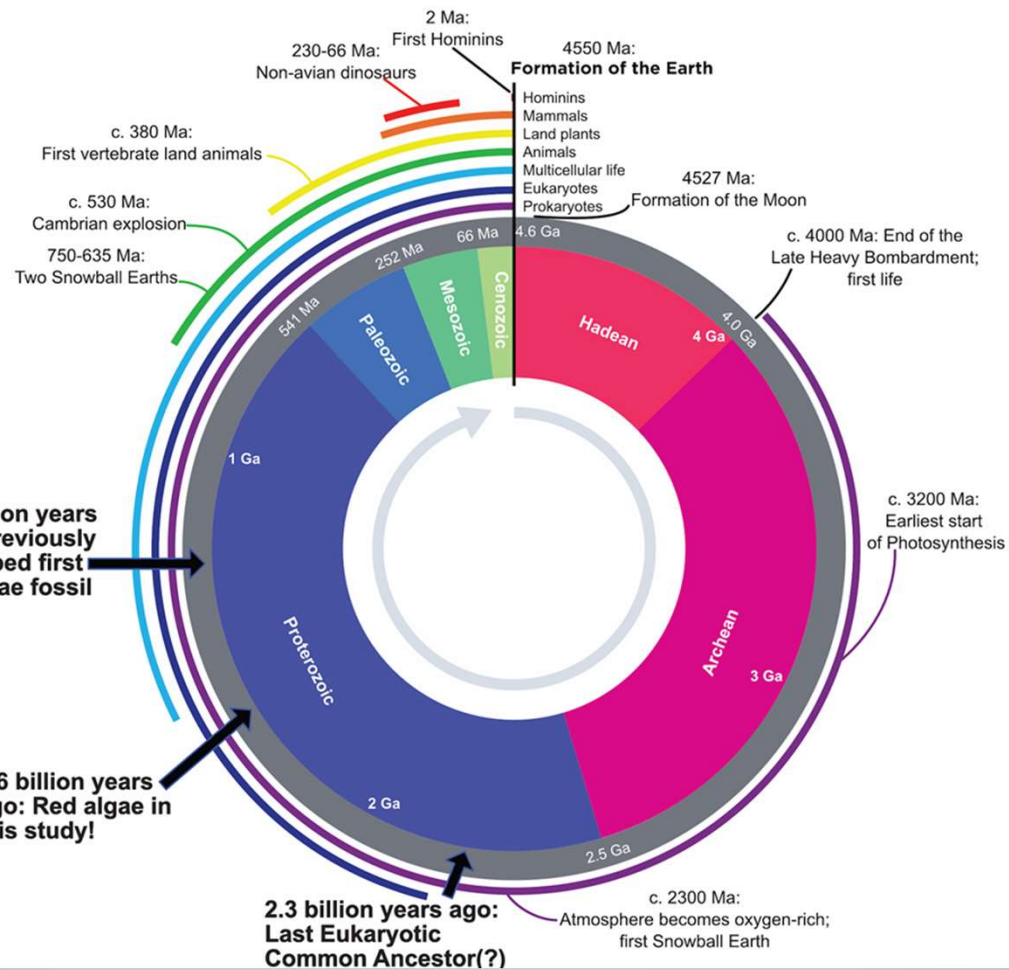
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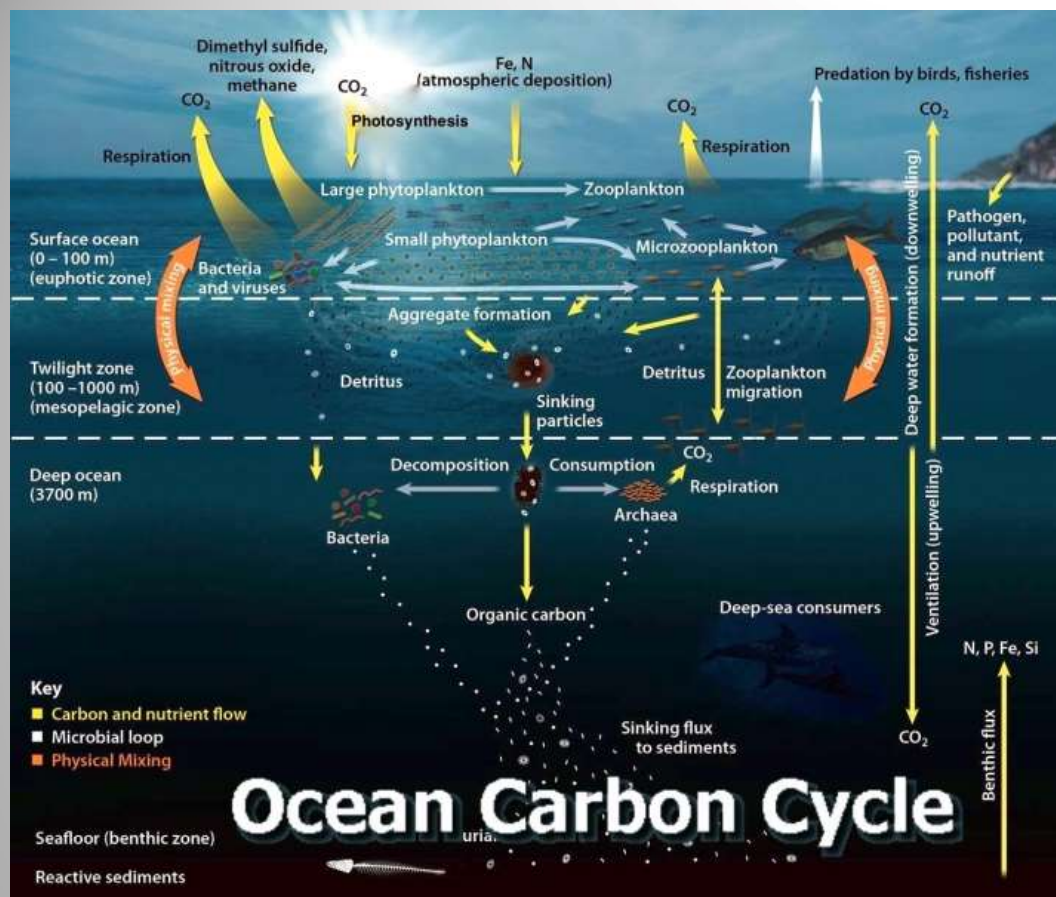
The role of the microbial community in the carbon cycle

Future developments

We believe that a transdisciplinary approach is needed to fully disentangle the microbial role on Earth.
